OPERATION TIME

Villa Russelia operates from the 1st of April until the 28th of February each year.

LOCATION

Villa Russelia is located in a quiet and private location on the west coast of Rhodes, in the middle of breathtaking scenery which offers the best of both worlds: a view to the magnificent green hills just behind the house, as well as to the deep blue of the Aegean Sea.

The property is located next to the traditional village of Kalavarda and the archaeological site of Ancient Kameiros, only 15 km from the airport and a 35 min. drive from the city of Rhodes. An organized beach with thick sand and shallow water is located 500m away from the property and offers facilities such as umbrellas/sun beds, one family beach bar, as well as two traditional restaurants. The archaeological site of Ancient Kameiros, one of the most impressive on the island, is located just 1km from the house.

The area around Kalavarda village is an ideal setting for nature and tradition lovers. Its architecture and surroundings offer visitors the opportunity to enjoy nature at its best through various outdoor activities such as diving, fishing, hiking, walking, swimming, cycling, while the surrounding area has many local cottage industries and small units producing ceramics, cattle farming and agricultural products, mainly citrus fruits, cereals and virgin olive oil. It is undoubtedly the ideal destination for those who aim on a relaxing vacation while blending with the local traditions and culture.

DESIGN CONCEPT

Villa Russelia has been designed preserving a classy and elegant style, while high quality building materials, such as stone and wood, have been used to give a feeling of luxury. In the inside, original vintage/classic and modern furnishing is matched together to create a cosy yet modern and functional living space.

ACCOMMODATION

The 220 m² villa can easily accommodate 8-10 people, offering three double bedrooms in the upper floor and one double bedroom in the main floor. Each bedroom has been tastefully decorated with high quality furnishing and mattresses, while all bedrooms share magnificent views to the sea and the garden. Each floor has its own, individually decorated bathroom with a bathtub and modern equipment. Comfort items such as fine linen and high quality bathroom amenities are offered free of charge.

ACTIVITIES AND SIGHTS CLOSE TO VILLA RUSSELIA

Traditions & Events

The customs and traditions of Rhodes are well preserved, with the local youth participating with singing and dancing at regular scheduled public events. Small festivals take place regularly during the summer months in many nearby villages with great success and attendance from tourists and locals alike.

Kalavarda (Village)

Kalavarda is an ideal setting for nature lovers. Its architecture and surroundings offer visitors the opportunity to enjoy nature at its best through various outdoor activities such as diving, fishing, hiking, walking, swimming, cycling, kite surfing. A beach with thick sand and shallow water, just perfect for kids, is located only 500m away from the property. Facilities offered nearby include umbrellas/sun beds, one family beach bar and two traditional restaurants. There you can also find organized kite-surfing facilities.

Ancient Kameiros

On the north-western shore of Rhodes, close to the promontory of Agios Minas (the Ancient Mylantio) lies the third of the island's ancient cities - Kameiros. Kameiros was one of the three large Doric cities of the island, which united with Ialysos and Lindos in the 5th century B.C. to create the powerful city - state of Rhodes. The archaeological site is located only 1 km from Villa Russelia.

The Valley of Butterflies

This is one of the most attractive destinations on the island. During August, thousands of butterflies of the genus Panaxia (species Quadripunctaria Poda) overwhelm the valley in order to reproduce. During the rainy period, the Butterflies in the caterpillar stage remain in the Mediterranean thicket (arbutus, myrtle and rush) feeding on the foliage. As the end of the wet season approaches, towards the end of May, the final stage is concluded and the butterfly in all her perfection makes her appearance in the form recognizable to us all. They move constantly towards areas of highest humidity is greatest, always following the "water ways", as the dry period progresses, they finally arrive at the valley. The valley of the Butterflies is located 15km from Kalavarda.

Tholos (Village)

Tholos (also called Theologos), is a colourful traditional village. A sprinkling of shops, tavernas, bars and restaurants can be found around the hotels and apartments. Its excellent beach can be breezy – an ideal place for windsurfers. The traditional way of life is still widely practiced in the village itself, and you should expect a very warm welcome from the friendly people living there. You should not miss to visit the picturesque church of Agios Spiridonas, with its lovely white bell tower. The old centre of Tholos is built in traditional Rhodian style. With tall shuttered buildings and narrow streets, Tholos (Theologos) village in Rhodes is a delight to wander through. Theologos is located only 10 km from Kalavarda.

Fanes (Village)

Fanes is a small village of about 1000 inhabitants, about 26km from Rhodes Town and only 3,8km from Kalavarda. The village is about 1km inland, and has a nice large sandy beach, which is ideal for kite surfing and windsurfing due to the strong winds and their direction. It also has a well weather protected fishing port, which makes it the base for many fishermen, which in turn offer their fresh fish at the local tavernas. You will get good local fresh fish at the restaurants of the area. The beach is not crowded and has parts where you can have peace. The waters though, are very clean and the wind makes you feel cool at the very hot days of summer. Note though, that the winds are usually strong in the area, and that you may find seaweed in the beach, a basic characteristic at this side of Rhodes. There is a kite surfing / windsurfing school at the beach, a good place to learn these action packed water sports!

Profitis Ilias

Mount Profitis Ilias, named after the biblical Elijah, rises to a height of 798 m and is covered by thick forest, consisting of a mix of mainly Calabrian pines, cedars and oaks and is an ideal as a destination for hikers and nature lovers. On top of the mountain, close to the monastery of the Profitis Ilias, visitors can rest at the hotel "Elafos", originally constructed in 1926 during the period of Italian administration. The mountain is located 20 km from Kalavarda.

Attavyros Mountain

Attavyros Mountain is the highest mountain of Rhodes which overlooks several small villages in the area. Attavyros is located between Agios Isidoros and Embona Villages. This lush green mountain is at times completely bathed in sunshine or hidden in the clouds, offering breathtakingly beautiful views. On the top, one can find the ruins of an old temple that was dedicated to god Zeus. The mountain is located 45 km from Kalavarda.

Agios Nikolaos Foundoukli (Church)

Late Byzantine church dedicated to St Nicholas containing 15th century frescoes. It is 20 km. from Kalavarda and along with the old Olive oil trees and Oriental Plane trees you'll find a restaurant with an astonishing view.

Lindos (Village)

One of the most popular destinations on the island and very well known for its particular style of architecture called "Arhontiko" as well as the majestic "Acropolis of Lindos". The village is located 50 km from Kalavarda.

Prasonissi

On the very edge of the island, 81km from Kalavarda, lies Prasonissi, a small island connected to the shore via a narrow lane of sand separating two bays. While the eastern bay is suitable for swimming and ideal for taking the first steps in windsurfing, the west side remains mostly windy and wavy and that is why it is considered a challenge, even for experienced surfers, giving Prasonissi the reputation as a dream destination for windsurfers and kite surfers over the years. Organised surf stations in the area provide all necessary equipment.

The Monastery of Panagia Skiadeni.

The beautiful Monastery of Panagia Skiadeni (Virgin Mary the “Shade casting”) is located a 60 minute drive southwest from Kalavarda. The hill is called Skiadi (“skiadi” = shady place). The monastery was founded around 1200, but the buildings that exist today date back to the 18th century, except for the chapel in the churchyard, which dates back to 1640. On the walls of the monastery of Panagia Skiadeni ancient marbles are embedded. Archaeologists believe that they come from a temple of Artemis, which pre-existed in this location. During the Lent period, the icon of Panagia Skiadeni is paraded in a procession that goes through all the villages of Rhodes. On the 8th of September a great feast takes place in the monastery, where, besides the Rhodians, many people from Chalki Island also come flocking.

Monolithos (Village).

Monolithos, a picturesque and historical village located 50 min from Kalavarda, is guarded by the famous and unique Monolithos Castle dated in 1476. Its name derived from the huge isolated rock (‘mono’ – one, ‘lithos’ – rock) that the Castle is built on, watching over the Southern Aegean waters since the 15th century, A.D. Monolithos is unique being the only place in Rhodes where visitors can enjoy the breathtaking views of the beautiful landscape which combines mountains, hillsides, and beaches, pine forests, historic monasteries scattered throughout the forests, a historical castle and fortress associated with fascinating history and legends.
